Cllr Hayday reported that resurfacing of the roads will be carried out soon although he has not been given a date yet.

Cllr Hayday reported he had received complaints about the recent festival at The Dashwood Arms Public House. This has been passed to WDC.

Cllr Hayday reported that BCC are to resurface the pavements. No dates have been given as yet.

Cllr Hayday reported that Red Kite have agreed that the extra parking spaces will be created behind George Lee Court. If the parking problems persist on Kings Street, Council will need to look into a TRO.

## Clerks Report

1. Regarding the request for a sign directing vehicles to Huckington Lane. BCC have advised the following: "Unfortunately we do not provide signs of this nature to private businesses. They are of course welcome to apply for a sign should they feel there is a desperate need, however there is a non-refundable application fee of £200 attached to that and no guarantee that a sign would be approved by the Traffic Management team".
2. Wheeler End are having a fun day on the Common on 18<sup>th</sup> July. WDC have promised the grass will be cut before this date.
3. Natwest lost the paperwork to change the details on the account. Luckily they have now found the paperwork and it should all be changed shortly.
4. The goal post has been delivered and is being used by the lads on Wheeler End Common.
5. Cllr Hayday, residents of George Lee Court I had a meeting with Red Kite re the parking. Red Kite decided that they are able to proceed with the construction of the 3 extra bays at the rear of George Lee Court. Red Kite have been in touch with the private owner next door and have agreed to put some additional fencing on top of her wall to mitigate her sight of the car park, and she is also happy that they proceed. Red Kite have had permission from Bucks County Council, to install the access protection marker line across both the roadway and next door's drive. Red Kite will also be looking to move the bins from the side of the building.
6. The Clerk had a site meeting with Red Kite at the Piddington Recreational Ground. Red Kite may be able to buy a piece of toddlers play equipment out of there Community Asset Fund. The Clerk is working with Red Kite on this and will report at a future meeting.

Cllr Pitcher reported that the dog waste bin opposite The Brickmakers Arms in Wheeler End doesn't get used very often. It would be better placed on the other side of the Common. The Clerk will contact WDC to see if can be moved.

Cllr Pitcher reported that at the bottom of Chips Hill the branches are growing out onto the Junction, if they catch the top of a lorry it could be dangerous. Cllr Digby will contact the householder.

Cllr Pitcher reported she was concerned about vehicles trying to pass other parked vehicles on Wheeler End Common. It had been discussed at a previous Council Meeting that a layby could be put in to assist passing cars. Cllr Pitcher will look at papers from the previous meeting.

Cllr Hackett raised the issue of Piddington Green which fronts the Road, next to the allotments. The Parish Council currently manage it. The Clerk will find out if WDC would sell it.

Cllr Storey reported that the main hedge fronting the road at the Recreational Ground is getting overgrown. The hedge fronting Princes Street needs also needs cutting back. The Clerk will contact Peter Gomme for quotes.

Cllr Storey reported that the signs at the MUGA needs replacing. Clerk to look into this.

Cllr Digby has contacted the owner of the shed at the allotments on several occasions but cannot get in contact with him. Cllr Digby will email the tenant to discuss the shed.
