Clerks Report

- 1. I have asked WDC re installing another 5mph sign on Wheeler End Common facing down Chipps Hill if coming from Piddington.
- 2. I have written to WDC re the telegraph poles that are still wobbly. The LAT is looking into this.
- 3. I have contacted TFB re the overgrown hedges on Wheeler End Common.
- 4. I reported the overgrown hedges at the ex Peacock Pub to TFB, there were already reports on their system from Parishioners. Still waiting for it to be cut back.
- 5. I have reported the problem of rubbish at the ex Peacock Pub to WDC. As this is privately owned WDC cannot do anything about it. I then contacted the Estate Agent, Duncan, Bailey and Kennedy about this issue and asked them to contact the owner re removing the rubbish from the site. The owner has withdrawn the property and at this current time isn't selling it. The Estate Agent agreed to email them on my behalf and ask them to remove the rubbish from the site.
- 6. I have reported the blocked drains at the bottom of Chips Hill to TFB.
- 7. I organised for the weeds on the footpaths around Piddington to be sprayed.
- 8. The AED Checks have been carried out.
- 9. Cllr Digby will install the Silent soldier by war memorial on Wheeler End Common.
- 10. There are 4 overgrown allotment plots that have not been cultivated this year. Council agreed to issue notice to the current tenants. Council agreed to strim the allotments. The Clerk will re-allocate.
